Speciality IPA [K-SIPA]

- Beer styles include Fruit Pale Ale, Belgian IPA, Black IPA, Brown IPA, Red IPA, Rye IPA, White IPA, Brut IPA, Sour IPA, Milkshake IPA, Fruit IPA, Raw IPA, Other Flavoured Pale Ale, Other Flavoured IPA
- Colour Range: All

Amber, Brown & Red Ale(up to 6.4%)

[K-ABRA]

- Beer styles include Amber Ales, Brown Ales, Red Ales, Dark Milds, Old Ales, 60/-, 70/-, 80/-, Scottish Heavy
- Colour Range: 9-35

Stout & Porter (up to 6.4%)

[K-SAP]

- Beer styles include British Stout, Irish Stout, Dry Stout, Milk Stout, Oat Stout, Breakfast Stout, Tropical Stout, Nitro Stout, British Porter, American Porter, Baltic Porter, Nitro Porter
- Colour Range: 17-40

Imperial & Strong Ale (6.5% and over)

[K-IMP]

- Colour Range: 6-40

Sour & Wild Ale [K-SOUR]

- Beer styles include Berliner Weisse, Flanders Red Ale, Oud Bruin, Lambic, Gueuze, Gose, Fruited Gose, Fruit Lambic, Brett Beer, Mixed Fermentation Sour Beer, Wild Speciality Beer
- Colour Range: 2-22



Speciality & Flavoured Beer

[K-SPF]

- Beer styles include Flavoured Beer, Fruit Beer, Spice, Herb or Vegetable Beer, Smoked Beer, Wood Aged Beer
- Embraces all styles of beer that contain a non-core brewing ingredient at a level intended to impart a distinctive and discernible flavour note or character.
